The Overseas Transition Support (OTS) is a bespoke structured programme designed to equip professionals for overseas market success. It is available to Singaporeans/PRs intending to work overseas, those who have already secured overseas roles with their companies, as well as those already working in overseas roles with their companies.

SGLN is managed by the Human Capital Leadership Institute (HCLI) and supported by the Singapore Economic Development Board (EDB). The SGLN OTS is also supported by the Singapore Global Network (SGN).



Key Features

- Structured support for Singapore citizens and Permanent Residents (PR) embarking on overseas roles
- End-to-end support to expedite learnings from the overseas role
- Structured learning in a strong community network to build confidence for leaders to excel internationally and seamlessly reap professional and personal success in overseas roles
- Ignite leaders' capacity and ambition to take on regional or global leadership roles

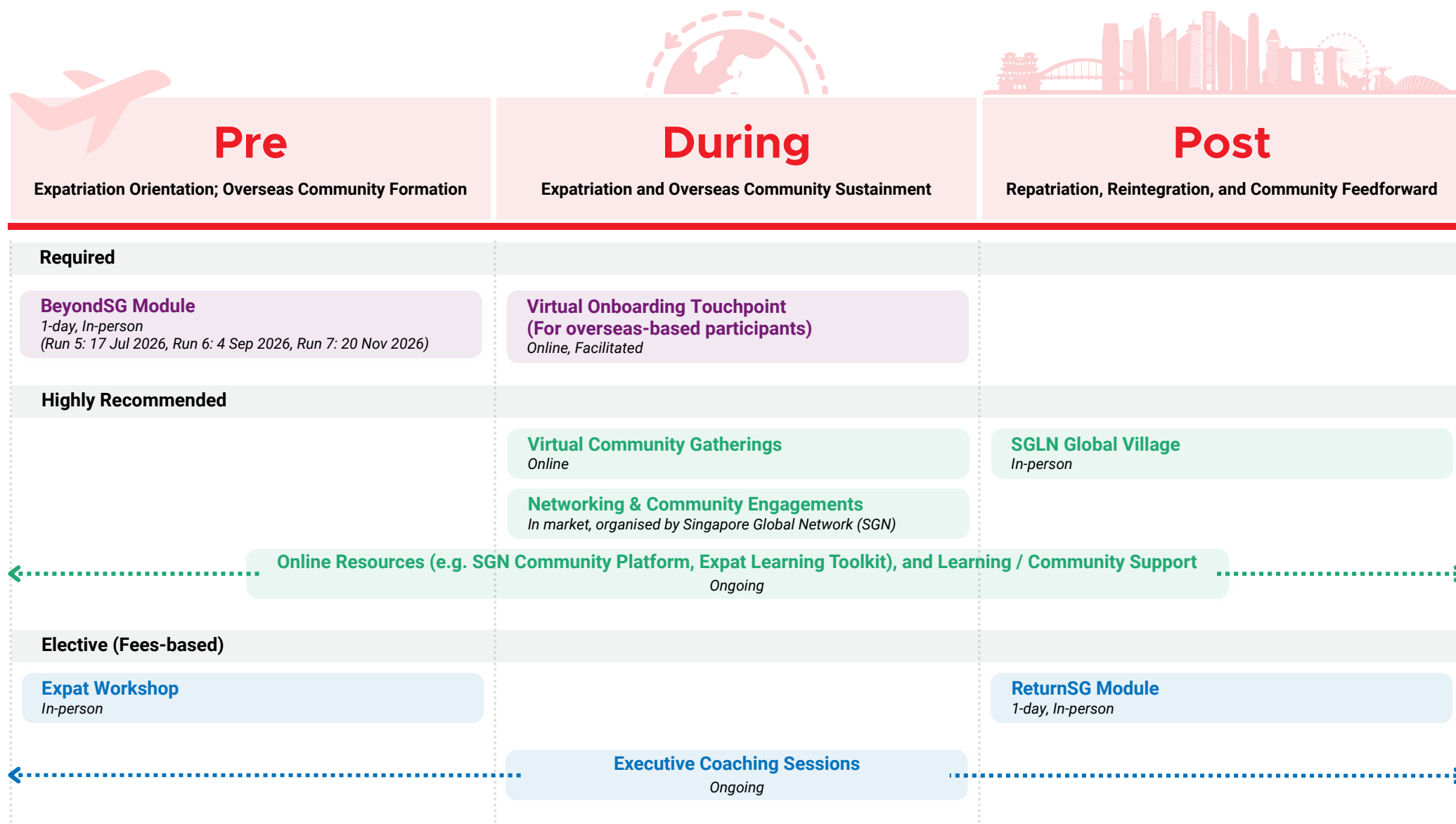

- Unlock powerful techniques for "Standing Out Globally," where you will gain actionable strategies to communicate with confidence, build impactful relationships across cultures, and project a strong, authentic presence on the international stage.

Go beyond simply surviving; learn to leverage this overseas work experience for profound personal and professional growth, setting the stage for success in your global leadership journey. Meet others on the same global path and start your overseas journey with a strong support network.

Online Resources

Access curated online resources such as the Expat Learning Toolkit and the Singapore Global Network (SGN) community platform to navigate your overseas transition with confidence and build meaningful connections.



Virtual Community Gatherings

These online sessions connect individuals preparing for or currently on overseas roles to foster a supportive peer network. Participants share experiences, exchange practical advice, and build relationships, mitigating feelings of isolation and enhancing cross-cultural adjustment.



Networking and Community Engagements

These facilitated events and activities help individuals build connections within their new host country and with other expatriates. They provide opportunities to establish professional relationships, integrate socially, and access local knowledge, accelerating their adaptation and overall well-being.



SGLN Global Village

SGLN Global Village celebrates cultural diversity and promotes global understanding through interactive experiences and knowledge sharing. It offers a platform for individuals to learn about different cultures, connect with people from around the world, and enhance their intercultural competence.

Elective* Learning Components



Expat Workshop

This workshop provides a deeper dive into self-assessment and development for overseas roles. It includes an expat profile assessment.

Participants will gain a comprehensive understanding of their expat profile, explore strategies for maximising their strengths, and create a personalised plan to address potential challenges in their upcoming transition.



ReturnSG Module

This module focuses on deepening global leadership capabilities shaped by international experience.

It helps returning professionals to leverage their overseas insights to strengthen their influence in multicultural and cross-border environments—preparing them to lead more effectively in global or regional roles back home and/or in subsequent overseas roles.



Executive Coaching Sessions

These personalised coaching sessions offer one-on-one guidance to support individuals through critical aspects of their overseas transition.

An experienced coach provides tailored support in areas such as navigating career changes, managing personal and professional challenges, and achieving success in their international role.

The SGLN OTS programme is valued at S\$5,000 (subject to GST). However, participants will be fully sponsored, with no additional fees related to 'Required' and 'Highly Recommended' components for confirmed SGLN OTS participants. Please note that optional elective offerings (e.g. executive coaching, expat workshop, ReturnSG module) will incur additional fees.
