The SGLN Launchpad is a six-month leadership development programme designed to equip aspiring mid-level professionals with the capabilities, community support, and confidence to take on regional or global leadership roles. This programme emphasises real-world learning through an in-person leadership module, professionally facilitated peer learning sessions, and a virtual sharing segment where participants craft and deliver a high-impact presentation to their peers. We encourage all SGLN Launchpad participants to attend the annual SGLN Learning Festival.

SGLN is managed by the Human Capital Leadership Institute (HCLI) and supported by the Singapore Economic Development Board (EDB).



Key Features

- Cohort-based programme, six-month duration
- Open to Singapore citizens and Permanent Residents (PRs)
- Designed for aspiring mid-level professionals with 5-10 years of experience
- Participants will become part of the SGLN Launchpad community, a growing peer network of aspiring global leaders
- Participants will gain knowledge and skills to enhance their readiness and capability for global leadership
- Participants will connect with a community of peers, industry professionals, and experts, and expand professional networks and collaboration opportunities
- All programme cohorts are invited to the annual SGLN Learning Festival, a platform to showcase innovative learning and celebrate achievements

For each run, there are 4 programme components:

01	Ignite Leadership Module 1-day, in person	Compulsory
02	SGLN Hangouts 4 sessions, 2 hours each	
03	Virtual Sharing Sessions 1 preparation session, 2 hours 3 sessions, 1 hour each	
04	SGLN Learning Festival Held annually in July, starting 2026	Strongly Encouraged

Ignite Leadership Module

1-day (in-person)

This full-day leadership module kickstarts the SGLN Launchpad programme, focusing on one of the four key learning outcomes. It culminates in a global speaker segment featuring senior business leaders, where participants gain authentic, lived leadership insights and reflections to complement the tools and frameworks explored earlier in the day. This experience lays the foundation for the leadership development journey ahead.



SGLN Hangouts

Monthly, 6 - 8pm
4 sessions

SGLN Hangouts are professionally facilitated learning circles where small groups tackle real leadership and business challenges in a confidential, high trust setting. Guided by expert facilitators, they are grounded in collective problem-solving, a disciplined process, and non-judgmental sharing.

Learning compounds through an apply-reflect-refine loop: apply insights at work between monthly Hangouts, return to share outcomes and best practices, exchange feedback, and reset commitments together. By the final session, each group creates a collective artefact that captures shared learning and prepares members for their Virtual Sharing Session. Informal cohort meetups between sessions are encouraged to deepen bonds and sustain progress.

The value of the SGLN Hangouts lies in experience sharing, which often sparks deeper learning than advice-giving. By sharing openly rather than prescribing solutions, peers surface lessons that are more relevant to one another and resonate more deeply. The result is a trusted advisory network that endures well beyond Launchpad – peers who show up at professional and personal inflection points with candid perspectives and support.

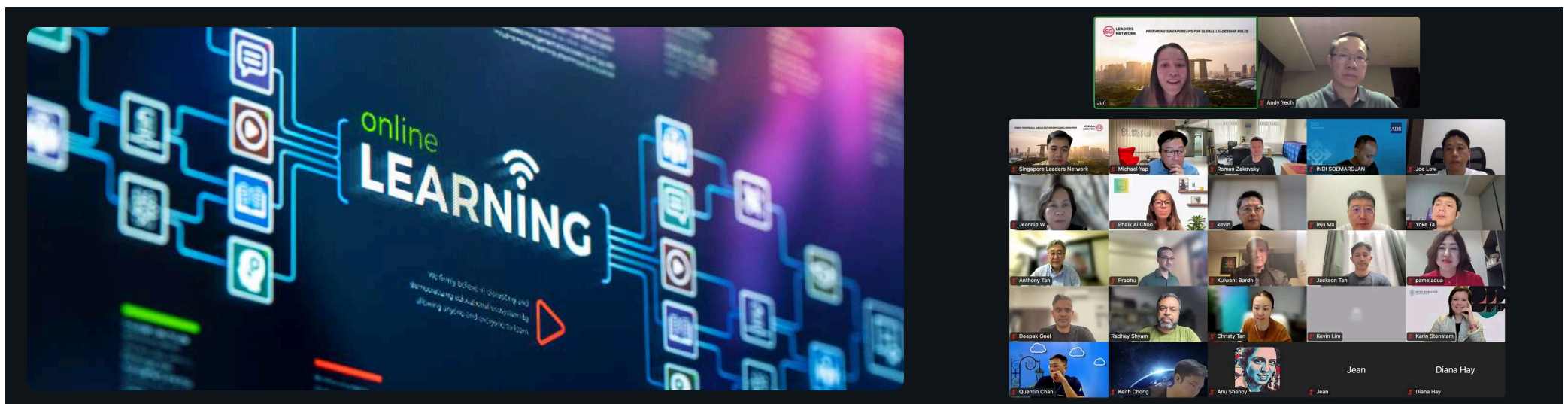


Virtual Sharing Sessions

Ongoing, 1 hour (virtual)

Continue the journey of growth and connection beyond the Ignite module and SGLN Hangouts with our Virtual Sharing Sessions. You will choose topics related to the Ignite Leadership Module learning outcomes to teach and share your insights learned for one hour to your fellow participants. It is a chance to craft and deliver a high-impact presentation – to inspire others, rally support for ideas you care about, and be rated by your peers on both turnout and resonance. The wider SGLN community will also be invited to attend these virtual sessions, where faculty members may provide additional insights. Participants will be required to attend at least two virtual sessions taught by other participants.

These online peer learning gatherings provide a dynamic space to revisit key concepts, exchange practical insights, and address real-world challenges in a collaborative setting. Stay connected with your cohort, expand your network, and receive ongoing support from facilitators and peers. These sessions are designed to reinforce your learning and empower you to confidently apply your new skills in your daily leadership practice.



SGLN Learning Festival

Annual Event every July

The annual SGLN Learning Festival allows participants to showcase their learning to a wider audience. This vibrant event is a powerful culmination of your shared journey, offering a unique platform to connect with a diverse community of leaders, showcase your growth, and gain inspiration from industry experts. The best-rated Virtual Sharing Session group or individuals will be invited to present their findings at this celebrated event. Eligibility Criteria

- Singapore citizens and PRs
- Professionals with 5–10 years of work experience
- Currently in mid-level roles with aspirations for regional or global leadership
- Demonstrated interest in leadership development and peer learning
- Open to both self-nominated and company-nominated applicants

Commitment Expectations

- Full-day attendance at the Ignite Leadership Module is compulsory
- Participation in all 4 of the SGLN Hangouts (2 hours each) is required
- Each participant must attend a 2-hour preparation session, teach 1 virtual sharing session and attend 2 other virtual sharing sessions
- Attendance at the annual SGLN Learning Festival is strongly encouraged
- Post-programme, participants are encouraged to stay active in the SGLN community (e.g. as facilitators or alumni contributors)



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
