The SGLN Supply Chain Leaders Programme brings together high-potential leaders from across Singapore's supply chain ecosystem to develop the capabilities, perspectives and networks required to shape the future of the industry. Designed for executives preparing for regional and global leadership roles, the programme combines immersive industry experiences, executive learning and cross-sector collaboration to equip participants to lead with greater strategic insight in an increasingly complex and interconnected world.

Beyond the programme, participants become part of the Singapore Leaders Network, an exclusive community of senior leaders, industry experts, mentors and policymakers committed to strengthening leadership across Singapore's key industries. The network provides ongoing opportunities to exchange perspectives, build meaningful relationships and contribute to the continued growth and resilience of Singapore's supply chain ecosystem.

SGLN Supply Chain Leaders Programme is part of the Singapore Leaders Network Industry Interest Groups (SIIG) initiative launched by Mr Gan Kim Yong, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Trade & Industry, Republic of Singapore, in September 2025.

MODULE 1

Decoding Modern Supply Chains

Modern supply chains sit at the intersection of geopolitics, technology, sustainability and global commerce. In this opening module, participants develop a systems understanding of the forces reshaping global value chains through executive dialogues, industry insights and an immersive decision-making simulation. By exploring real-world scenarios and emerging trends, including AI as a strategic capability, participants strengthen their ability to navigate complexity and lead with greater strategic judgement.



Develop a systems perspective on modern supply chains

Develop a holistic understanding of modern supply chain ecosystems and the interconnected forces shaping business competitiveness.



Navigate disruption with strategic foresight

Recognise emerging global trends - including AI, automation and geopolitical developments - and how they are reshaping supply chain strategy and competitive advantage.



Master leadership through systems thinking

Strengthen decision making by recognising interdependencies, managing complexity and evaluating trade-offs across end-to-end supply chains.

MODULE 2

From Credible to Compelling: Leading Beyond the Four Walls

Make the content clear. Use stories to connect.

Today's supply chain leaders create value by influencing across functions, organisations and global ecosystems. This module equips participants to lead beyond organisational boundaries by strengthening executive communication, stakeholder influence and cross-cultural leadership. Through immersive masterclasses, practical leadership conversations and real-world examples, participants develop the confidence and capability to build alignment, navigate complexity and lead effectively across diverse teams, cultures and geographies.



Build a confident and credible leadership presence

Strengthen your ability to communicate with clarity, confidence and authenticity in senior leadership settings.



Communicate to influence

Develop the ability to craft and deliver compelling leadership narratives that align people, drive action, and create shared meaning in complex environments.



Lead across cultures and boundaries

Build the cultural intelligence and collaborative leadership needed to influence across organisations, geographies and distributed teams.

MODULE 3

The Resilient Leader: Versatility in Volatility

Sustainable leadership begins with the leader. As the demands of senior leadership continue to intensify, technical expertise alone is no longer enough. This module explores the personal capabilities that enable leaders to navigate complexity with clarity, resilience and purpose. Through executive conversations, guided reflection and an immersive leadership development workshop, participants strengthen the mindset, judgement and inner compass needed to lead themselves and others through uncertainty.



Know yourself as a leader

Build greater self-awareness by understanding the experiences, values and motivations that shape how you lead.



Lead with clarity and purpose

Strengthen your decision-making by developing a clear sense of purpose and an internal compass that remains steady under pressure.



Sustain high performance

Develop the mindset and practices needed to navigate uncertainty, adapt to change and sustain high performance over the long term.

MODULE 4

The Intelligent Supply Chain: Leading in the Age of AI

Artificial intelligence is redefining how supply chains are designed, operated and continuously optimised. For senior leaders, the opportunity extends beyond adopting new technologies to reimagining how organisations create value, make decisions and compete. This module equips participants to lead AI-enabled transformation by exploring practical applications, emerging technologies and the leadership capabilities required to build intelligent, future-ready supply chain organisations.



Harness AI for competitive advantage

Understand where AI creates the greatest value across the supply chain and identify opportunities to transform business performance.



Lead AI-enabled transformation

Build the leadership capabilities needed to drive adoption, manage organisational change and translate AI strategy into execution.



Build intelligent and responsible organisations

Design resilient, data-driven organisations by integrating AI, governance and responsible innovation into business decision-making.

MODULE 5

Designing for Impact: Supply Chain Solutions Lab

The Supply Chain Solutions Lab is the programme's signature capstone experience, bringing together everything participants have learned throughout the programme. Working in multidisciplinary teams, participants tackle real industry challenges facing Singapore's supply chain ecosystem, applying strategic thinking, AI-enabled innovation and systems leadership to develop practical recommendations with the potential for lasting industry impact.



Solve real industry challenges

Apply programme learning to complex supply chain issues facing Singapore.



Design practical solutions

Combine systems thinking, AI and collaborative innovation to develop scalable recommendations.



Influence senior decision-makers

Present evidence-based recommendations to industry leaders with confidence and clarity.



Collaborate across industries

Work with peers from diverse organisations to broaden perspectives and strengthen leadership capability.



Create lasting impact

Develop solutions that contribute to organisational performance and Singapore's future as a global supply chain hub.

Industry in Action: Learn From The Ecosystem

Industry in Action is the programme's signature experiential learning component, providing participants with exclusive access to the organisations, infrastructure and capabilities that have established Singapore as a leading global trade, logistics and supply chain hub. Through curated site immersions and conversations with senior industry leaders, participants gain first-hand insight into the innovations, technologies and strategic decisions that keep global supply chains moving.

Beyond operational learning, participants develop a deeper appreciation of the partnerships, ecosystem and long-term investments that underpin Singapore's competitiveness. The experience is designed to foster not only new perspectives, but also a shared sense of responsibility to strengthen Singapore's future as a trusted global supply chain hub.



Supply Chain Futures Summit and Graduation

The Supply Chain Futures Summit is the programme's signature capstone event, bringing together senior industry leaders, policymakers, partners and participants to explore the future of Singapore's supply chain ecosystem. As the culmination of the Supply Chain Solutions Lab, participant teams present recommendations to real-world industry challenges, demonstrating their ability to translate strategic insight into practical, high-impact solutions.

More than a showcase of ideas, the Summit is a platform for dialogue, collaboration and industry engagement. Participants receive feedback from senior leaders, exchange perspectives with key stakeholders and contribute fresh thinking that has the potential to strengthen Singapore's position as a trusted global supply chain hub. It reflects the programme's commitment to developing leaders who not only understand the ecosystem but actively contribute to shaping its future.

The programme concludes with a Graduation Ceremony, recognising participants' successful completion of the programme and welcoming them into the SGLN Supply Chain Leaders community, an enduring network of leaders committed to advancing Singapore's supply chain ecosystem.

The fee for SGLN Supply Chain Leaders Programme is S\$10,000 per participant. However, participants for Run 1 will be fully sponsored.

Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis, and successful applicants will be notified by 30th August 2026

Eligibility Criteria

- Singaporeans and PRs
- Preferably a minimum of 10 years of work experience, mid-to-senior leadership level
- Applicants should be working in the supply chain industry or in supply chain roles (but not limited to): Senior Manager / Director / VP or Head of Supply Chain, Senior Manager / Director / VP of Logistics or Distribution, Head of Procurement / Strategic Sourcing, Director of Operations / Manufacturing, Head of Planning (demand planning, S&OP, inventory planning), Director of Warehousing & Fulfilment, Head of Fleet / Transportation Management, Director of Trade Compliance / Customs, Chief Supply Chain Officer or Chief Operating Officer (with supply chain remit)
- Executives currently in or identified with potential and strong aspirations to take on regional or global leadership roles in the supply chain industry within the next five years
- Overseas work experience will be an advantage
- Open to both company-nominated and self-nominated applicants, with priority given to the former
- Availability to attend all compulsory programme components

- From your perspective, does this applicant have the potential to take on a global or regional leadership role within the supply chain industry in the next five years? Please elaborate and share specific examples of the applicant's qualities and potential.
